

Child Development Theorist Research

1. Students will be split into groups of 4 and given one of the theorists.
 - a. Sigmund Freud
 - b. Jean Piaget
 - c. Lev Vygotsky
 - d. B.F. Skinner
 - e. Abraham Maslow
 - f. Albert Bandura
 - g. Robert Coles
 - h. Lawrence Kohlberg

2. Students will research their theorist using their ipads in class. They will provide:
 - a. Background information
 - b. Theory of Child Development
 - c. Application of the theory
 - d. An example of the theory in action
 - e. At least 3 references

3. Students will then create a presentation to teach the class about their theorist. The presentation will include all of the above mentioned information. There will be at least 6 slides.
 - a. The title slide will include the names in the group, the theorist's name, theorist's picture, and birth and death date.
 - b. If the theorist's theory is split into stages, the group will use sufficient slides to explain the each stage in full.

4. Students will present the presentation to the class as 'the expert' on the theorist. They will need to be able to answer 3 questions from the class about their theorist.
