

Assignment 3 - Rearrange a Room - DUE Date April 28

Instructions: First, you will read through the attached article. Each part will be worth a grade. The final product will be 1 more grade. 4 grades total. :)

Part 1: Decisions

- Decide on a room and ask permission to rearrange if you need it. Think of rooms that need a spruce! Your bedroom, the living room, the family room - Maybe your parents would like a fresh look!
- Take a before picture.
- Thoroughly clean the space. Start high and end low. You will probably have to clean again at the end.
- Discard items you no longer need/want. (Ask your parents first.)

Part 1 documenting:

- In your class folder, create a google slide presentation titled "Rearranging a Room."
- Title it "Rearranging my _____" whichever room you are arranging.
- Slide 2, load the BEFORE picture of the room.
- Slide 3, give 3 tips for cleaning a room - and a picture of you cleaning the room.

Part 2: Planning

- Create a drawing of the floorplan of your room. You can use an online program such as livingspaces.com, roomstyler.com, etc, OR you can freehand the floorplan. However, be as careful as possible and keep proportions and scale in mind.
- You will use this floorplan to visually draw your 'new space.' You can even cut out shapes to represent your furniture.

- Remember to keep the space and its needs in mind while you arrange.
 - Do you need an 'office space' in this room?
 - Do you need a relaxing space?
 - Do you need a media space?
 - Don't forget traffic patterns!
- Take a picture of your final floor plan.

Part 2 documenting:

- Slide 4: title: Planning -
- Slide 5: picture or pictures of your different floor plans with the choice one circled

Part 3: Rearranging!

- Start rearranging. Take progress pictures! Or a timelapse video - document the process. :)
- If you are redecorating, too, think about maybe switching some things from throughout the house that could be used in the space. Or maybe you have things in the attic or the garage that could be used?
- Clean again at the end if you need to.

- Slide 7: load your process pictures or video.
- Slide 8: Take an AFTER Photo of our room and load it here.
- Slide 9: Type 1 paragraph explaining your choices for the room. Think about elements and principles of design. Think of the traffic patterns and space usage.
