

Commercial Interior Design Project Part III

After you have chosen your scenario and designed your floor plan, you need to color the floor plan appropriately. And cut it out. THE BOARD Now you will find examples from magazines of :

1. The furniture you want in your space (if it is on the floor plan, it needs to be represented on the board). (5 pictures printed or cut out)
2. The lighting for your space. (general, decorative or task) (2 pictures printed or cut out)
3. The flooring and/or floor covering (rugs?) You will use free samples from hardware stores (Home Depot are for sure free!)
4. Walls (color or texture) Again use paint swatches from the hardware store (at least 2)
5. You will need 5 accessories. These can be pillows, paintings, knick knacks, vases, whatever you want to add 'umph' to your space.(5 pictures printed or cut out)
6. Window Treatments: swatches or pictures (2 printed or cut out examples)
7. Label your Color Scheme on your board, too.

You will then back these examples and place them on your foam board. All of the above PLUS your floor plan MUST be on your board. If you want you may name your commercial space and put that on your board as well. **EVERYTHING must be labeled Example Board**
